AS WHEREAS both the parties have agreed with each other's regarding the Contractual Agreement/deed on the following terms and conditions:-

## NOW THIS DEED FURTHER WITNESSETH AS UNDER:-

### TERMS OF REFERENCE

Responsibility of the "HCU"

(a). Health Care Unit would be responsible to paste the Bar Code/QR Code label on each bag as per category of schedule-1 of prescribe BMW Rule 2016

(b) Will take steps to segregate the waste at the source of generation in accordance with schedule-I & II of BMW (Management & Handling) Rules in compliance with standard prescribed rules.

(c) The Party Number 1 reserves the right to refuse lifting of Bio-Medical Waste if it is not properly segregated as per cited rules.

(d) Will maintain the record of Bio-Medical Waste generated/handed over.

Responsibility of "Service Provider"

(a) Will manage the website where all data pertaining to receive, collect, transport and dispose off the BMW, handed over by HCU will be maintained.

(b) Will provide the QR code labels stickers of all categories (Red, Blue, Yellow & White) on chargeable basis @ Rs1.20 per QR Labels plus GST Extra (@18%) as when required ,which should be displayed on bags, to be scanned during the disposal of the BMW by the Service Provider coming to pick the material.

JOINT PROCEDURE ORDER

The Client and Operator both will jointly prepare a detailed procedure order covering the working methodology to be adopted during the terms of contract and the same will become approach paper for the contract.

### **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- 1. The terms of this Agreement shall remain effective/in force for a period from 01-Jan-240 31-Dec -. 24
- 2. The first party Kashmir Health Care Systems will charge Rs 300 + GST(18%) = RS 354 per monthfor maintenance of the website and QR Code labels will be charged as @Rs1.20 Paisa per labels + GST
- 3. Taxes such as Service Tax or any other Tax or charges would be extra
- 4. Will renew their contractual agreement one-month before the date of expiry.
- 5. An increase of 10% extra chargewill be calculated on the current Monthly Charges and Bar Code Labels at the time of renewal of this agreement in the subsequent year.
- 6. No change or modification or waiver of any of the terms of this agreement shall be effective unless agreed to in writing and signed by a duly authorized officer of each of the parties hereto.
- 7. Neither party shall transfer and/or assign the rights granted under the Contractual Agreement without the prior intimation to and permission of the other party or without obtaining a written undertaking by the

proposed assignee/transferee agreeing to assume all said party's obligations and covenants contained herein.

8. This agreement shall be governed by the laws prevailing in Jammu & Kashmir.

9. All notices, requests, demands and other communications required/permitted to be given under this agreement shall be in writing and delivered by hand against receipt, or sent by registered mail/e-mail-kkashmirhealthcaresystem@gmail.comOR at the permanent correspondence addressKashmir Health Care Systems, Shah-i-Hamdan Complex, Kak Sarai, Karan Nagar, 190010, Srinagar of M/S Kashmir Health Care Systems.
